• The head of the guitar is at eye level (guitar is at a 45° angle) • Face of guitar straight up and down (not angled back) • Sit up straight and relax

the shoulders and neck Right Arm & Hand • Right forearm rests on the guitar in front of the elbow • Right wrist is straight with a relaxed arch • Right hand plays around the rosette
